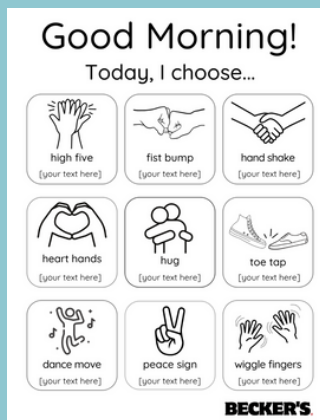

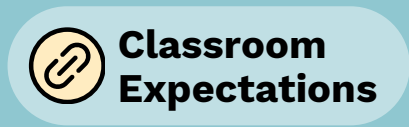

Daily Schedule

Use with the example photos, or insert photos of your own students! Edit the wording to reflect the phrases used in your setting for each time of day.

Two formats:

- wide strips handy for pocket charts and other vertical orientations
- card style for horizontal schedules and now/next cards

Each format includes four pages of suggested phrases & example photos.

Make your own Daily Schedule!

Step 1. If desired, replace images with photos of your students during each time of day.
Step 2. Edit the labels needed to reflect the language used in your setting.
Step 3. Print on cardstock.
Step 4. Cut out each rectangle.
Step 5. Use a pocket chart, velcro dots, or magnets to arrange the schedule cards in your space as needed.
